






# Why saving energy?

The production of heat, electricity, water and the disposal of waste are costly and affect the environment.

Our tips will help you save a lot of money and also protect the climate.

The following saving assumptions are based on the average consumption of a three-headed household. The costs and savings may vary from one household to the other.



# Electricity

- Unused electrical devices should be not only deactivated, but also separated from the mains (avoid stand-by, e. g. with disconnectable power strips)
  - → Savings: approx. 100 euros/year
- 2. A lid over the cooking pot helps save 30 percent of energy
  - → Savings: approx. 50 euros/year
- 3. Heat up water in an electric water heater instead of on an electric stove
  - → Savings: approx. 40 euros/year
- 4. Protect the refrigerators against heat: do not place them next to the cooker or the radiator
  - → Savings: approx. 20 euros/year
- When replacing a device: buy electrical appliances of classes A+ to A+++ instead of B or C
  - → Savings: approx. 75 euros/year



#### Heat

- Do not heat with ovens, hotplates or running warm water! There is a risk of house fires, flooding and high maintenance costs.
- 2. Quick open ventilation instead of tilted windows; while doing so, set the thermostat at "\*"
  - → Savings: approx. 180 euros/year
- Seal up windows and doors against draughts
  → Savings: approx. 20 euros/year
- 4. Do not put anything in front of the heating: furniture, curtains, clothes horses prevent the heat circulation.
  - → Savings: approx. 20 euros/year
- Reducing temperatures in rooms by 1°C saves 5 to 10 percent of the heating costs (thermostat at "3")
  - → Savings: approx. 135 euros /year
- 6. Nightly lowering of room temperatures at 16°C (thermostat at "2")
  - → Savings: approx. 135 euros/year



## Imprint

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#### Water

- Washing machine: forgo prewashing, fully loaded, eco programme, 40°C instead of 60°C
  - → Savings: approx. 100 euros/year
- 2. Use low-flow showerheads, aerators on the tap, eco-flush-stop on the toilet
  - → Savings: approx. 100 euros/year
- 3. Showering consumes less water than bathing
  - → Savings: approx. 300 euros/year
- 4. Use dishwasher rather than your hands to clean your dishes, eco programme,
  - → Savings : approx. 35 euros/year
- If possible, heat up only the actually needed quantity of water (0.2 I instead of 1 I for a cup of tea)
  - → Savings: approx. 10 euros/year



### Waste

- 1. Separate waste: dispose of plastic, glass, paper and residual waste in the appropriate bins
  - → Savings: approx. 50 euros/year
- Take batteries, electronic scrap and used oil to the retailer or the recycling centre; the recycling centre also accepts paint residues and other hazardous wastes.
- 3. Buy products with little packing material, use reusable packaging (bottles, cups, bags ...)
  - → Savings: at least. 5 euros/year
- 4. Printing on both pages of a paper: reduction of paper consumption
  - → Savings: approx. 10 euros/year
